APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Application Form: The applicant should complete Part A carefully in his or her own handwriting; the parent or guardian should complete Part B. Please attach a recent photograph.

Application Fee: After completing the application, please return it along with a non-refundable \$50 check to the Admissions Office.

To Secure Applicant's Place: A tuition deposit of \$900 is required to secure a place in the school. This deposit is repayable at the request of parents up until two weeks before the scheduled enrollment date after which it becomes non-repayable.

Transcript: The applicant's parent or guardian must complete the enclosed Student Records Release form and give it to the applicant's school counselor. The school will then forward the information directly to us.

Letters of Recommendation: If you are a jr. high or high school student, please give recommendation forms to your English and math teachers and one to another teacher of your choice. An elementary school student should give one recommendation to his or her current teacher and ask two close associates to write recommendations. Completed recommendations should be sent directly to Delphi.

Interview: A preliminary interview is conducted by phone. All applicants also receive personal interviews and testing prior to enrollment. Visits to the school should occur on weekdays when classes are in session. If distance precludes a visit, we will try to arrange testing and interviews in your area.
