PERSONAL EXPENSE ACCOUNT SUMMER SESSION

This form should be used as a worksheet to estimate the student's *personal* expenses for the summer session. Each student needs money for a weekly allowance, shopping and emergency medical expenses. Parents approve expenditures by completing and signing this form.

The funds are passed to the school at the time of enrollment. Traverler's checks or a personal checking account are the recommended form. Credit cards may not be used for opening a student's personal account. Personal checks may be cashed in the the snack bar during regularly scheduled hours. There is a \$10 charge for any returned checks. Bankwires sent separately for personal money will have a \$15 fee deducted.

A Middle School student will have a Personal Teacher (PT) and an Upper School student will have a Faculty Advisor (FA), who disburses the student's personal money if it isn't kept in a checking account. Allowance and any other personal expense money is given to the student from this account as designated by the parents. A written account of all transactions is kept.

PERSONAL EXPENSE ACCOUNT ITEMS

•ALLOWANCE:

This is for purchases at the snack bar, for personal needs and for shopping. We suggest \$15-\$20 a week for students under 13 years, and \$20-\$25 per week for older students: \$_____ a week x _____ weeks = \$_____

For off-campus trips such as to Seattle, your child may want shopping money (\$20-\$100). \$_____

•MEDICAL EMERGENCIES:

Delphi requires that \$140 be available in case your child needs to see a doctor as local doctors do not bill. This amount would also include any medications needed for illness.

Note: If a student has a personal checking account, this money must be kept separately by the PT/FA . \$ 140.00

•A BIRTHDAY:

If your child's birthday occurs during his/her stay at Delphi, include approximately \$40 to help celebrate. Note: If a student has a personal checking account, this money will be held separately by the PT/FA.

•BICYCLE HELMET:

Students under age 16 are required by Oregon law to obtain and wear a helmet when riding a bicycle. You may bring your own or purchase one if your child will be riding a bicycle on campus. (Approximate cost \$15-\$20.)

•OPTIONAL-TRIP TO THE OREGON SHAKESPEARE FESTIVAL IN ASHLAND:

For Upper School English-speaking students who will be attending the Shakespeare Festival, the additional cost is \$225. This fee is separate from the activities fee and pays for two plays, back stage tour, lodging and meals.
